A rabies tag alone will not be accepted as verification as it does not give the information regarding the specific animal.</p> <p>DHPP: \$10.00 this vaccine prevents four different viruses: canine distemper, infectious hepatitis, parainfluenza, and parvovirus.</p> <p>Bordetella: \$15.00 this vaccine is for the prevention of kennel cough. The initial dose must be followed with a booster in one month and then every 6 months thereafter. Detailed information regarding recommended vaccine schedules and monthly vaccine clinic information can be found here. We also sell a variety of dewormer products, flea and tick preventatives and heartworm preventative. These products are only available for animals that have been seen within the year at either a spay/neuter clinic or vaccine clinic.</p>
