<b>Other</b>	<p>To automatically qualify for financial assistance, you can provide one of the following:</p> <p>Currently receiving WIC – with Statement of qualifying benefit period</p> <p>Currently receiving Medicaid – with Statement of qualifying benefit period</p> <p>Medicaid documents must be provided for the head of household or other adult living in the home.</p> <p>Current receiving Food Stamps (SNAP) – with Statement of qualifying benefit period</p> <p>If you do not have any of the above, you must supply the following in order to be considered for financial assistance.</p> <p>Proof of income – Earned and unearned (gross) income for all persons residing in the home. (Gross income is what you have before taxes or anything is taken out. You can show “earned income” with your paycheck stubs for the past month. “Unearned” income is money you</p>

get that is not a paycheck. This could be child support or unemployment compensation benefits or disability benefits that you get.

If you are self-employed, you must show a copy of last year's income tax return.

You must also provide:

Valid Proof of identity – State issued photo id/driver's license, a federal, state or local government, or military ID card.

<b>Qualifications</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Qualify as Low-Income: Capital Humane Society will review requests for assistance and determine if a cat owner is eligible based on federal income guidelines. Examples include: recipient of Medicaid, SNAP (food stamps), WIC, or other low-income government benefits or programs.</li> <li>2. Unaltered Cat: Only income eligible cat owners with an unaltered cat are eligible.</li> <li>3. Residency: Reside in Lincoln or Lancaster County.</li> </ol> <p>You will need to bring a photo ID and proof of your eligibility (SNAP card, Medicaid card, eWic card, etc.) to set up an appointment.</p>
<b>Application</b>	<p>If you are interested in participating in this program, please visit our Admissions &amp; Assessment Center at 2320 Park Blvd during regular business hours to set up an appointment for your cat(s) to be spayed/neutered.</p>
<b>Other</b>	<p>Limited to three cats only  Upon completion of the program, the owner will be responsible for ongoing veterinary care of the animal. Our goal is for the cat owner to establish a relationship with a community veterinary clinic after sterilization. We will provide the owner with a \$10.00 voucher one year after the cat has been spay/neutered and vaccinated for rabies. This voucher can be used at a community veterinary clinic, of the owner's choosing, for the cat's next rabies vaccination.</p>
