Check-in & Pick-up Location

WeSNiP, 2505 Cedarwood Ave., Bellingham, WA. Cats are transported from our office in Bellingham to Stanwood for surgery.

Check-in and pick-up times vary: Details are provided when your appointment is scheduled. Allow 30 minutes for both check-in and pick-up.

Carrier: All cats must be in a hard shell, plastic carrier that is safe and secure. A single layer of cotton liner inside the carrier. One cat per carrier. Please keep toys at home (do not bring toys in carrier)

Food/Treats and Water Instructions

Cats should have access to water at home prior to coming in for surgery. All food/treats should be removed by midnight the night prior to surgery. If your cat is an indoor / outdoor cat we strongly suggest bringing the cat indoors the evening prior to your appointment.

Do not put any containers containing food or water in the cat's carrier when bringing in for surgery.

Important Post-Operative Instructions:

Keep your pet indoors!

Males – at least 24 hours.

Females – at least 48 hours.

Offer your cat food and water once it is home.

Check your pet's incision daily. Keep the incision dry and clean.

Do not allow your pet to excessively lick or chew incisions.

DO NOT give human pain medicine to your pet! It can be fatal.
